



COMMEMORATION OF THE THREDBO ROAD COLLAPSE

This July marks the 20th anniversary of the Thredbo Road Collapse, a Commemorative Flare Run and Ecumenical Remembrance service will be held to remember those who lost their lives.

The Flare Run will take place under the starry alpine sky – this is a dedicated silent flare run, it is felt this to be a fitting commemoration for a group of people who loved the mountains and Thredbo.

Sunday, the community, friends, families and colleagues will come together in the Thredbo Chapel for an Ecumenical Remembrance Service. Following there will be wreath laying at the Thredbo Memorial Community Centre, here you can also leave a special message on memory cards that will be available.
