

Thredbo Statement regarding Gunbarrel Chairlift

Thredbo can confirm there was an isolated incident affecting a single chair on Gunbarrel Chairlift at approximately 3pm on Monday 22 July 2019. The guest involved in the incident sustained minor bruising only. No other guests or chairs were affected.

Stuart Diver, General Manager Thredbo said, "The safety of our guests and our people is the number one priority at Thredbo. The incident has been thoroughly investigated by our team of experts, SafeWork NSW, the manufacturers of the chairlift and an independent engineer.

"Following the investigation, we can confirm that this was an isolated incident caused by a freak gust of wind. Gunbarrel Chairlift resumed operations on Wednesday 24 July 2019."
