

Food Waste Recycling

Food waste is collected daily by the Village crew, the waste is emptied into our Closed Loop Organics machine and after 24 hours your food waste comes out as compost, which can be used outside Kosciuszko National Park.

What you **CAN** and **CAN NOT** put in your Food Organic bins;

CAN

- ✓ Can put scraps from food prep in the food organic bin
- ✓ Can put egg shells in the food organic bin
- ✓ Can put coffee grounds & tea leaves in the food organic bin
- ✓ Can put raw and cooked meat and fish in the organic bin
- ✓ Can put small bones in the food organic bin e.g. chicken or fish bones
- ✓ Can put paper napkins in the food organic bin



CAN NOT

- ✗ **CAN NOT** put large bones in the food organic bin e.g. ribs or T-bone
- ✗ **CAN NOT** put Oyster, Scallop, Mussel or Clam shells in the food organic bin
- ✗ **CAN NOT** put metal, plastic or bio degradable cutlery in the food organic bin
- ✗ **CAN NOT** put any plastic or packaging in the food organic bin
- ✗ **CAN NOT** put any tea bags in the food organic bin
- ✗ **CAN NOT** put cooking oil in the food organic bin – however we do recycle cooking oil, ask Environmental Services for more details.

These items **CAN NOT** go in the Food Organics bin as they will not break down in our Closed Loop Organics Machine. Please place these items in the General waste bin.
